
## DDAC (District De-addiction Centre)

A community awareness program on District De-Addiction and door to door campaigning conducted by DDAC, Balangir team of People's Forum at khujenpali village of Balangir District.




International Day for Persons with Disabilities

- ❖ **MAMI Puri** have rescued 10 mentally ill person and providing them shelter and treatment.




## DONATIONS
